In fact, if you are in Dothan, you are in the heart of peanut country; the majority of all the peanuts grown in the United States are grown within a 100 mile radius of Dothan. Plan a return trip in November for the National Peanut Festival, the nation's largest peanut festival. Drawing more than 200,000 attendees, the Festival is held annually to honor local peanut farmers and celebrate the harvest season.
